

# Street Report

SAFE AND FRIENDLY | DECEMBER 2019



The following data and information is provided to the Historic Core BID for tracking purposes. The information contained in this report is for activities reported in December 2019. The data and information is obtained from Ambassadors conducting patrols and entered in Statview.

#### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

**December 3, 2019** - While on his routine patrol, Sergeant Ramos witnessed two individuals from a distance engaging into a verbal altercation at around 2230 hours. As Ramos was attempting to intervene, he noticed one of the individuals produce a skateboard and hit the other individual in the head. Ramos called for backup immediately and called LAPD as well. Once multiple safety ambassadors arrived on scene, they were able to contain both suspects. LAFD was also dispatched to aid the victim, who was hit with the skateboard. LAPD arrived shortly after and took statements from all parties. Safety ambassadors were cleared from the scene once LAPD rule the situation as mutual combat.

**December 5, 2019** - At around 0200 hours, Officer Solorio was patrolling the area of 7th and Broadway when he heard a fire alarm ring out. Solorio contacted the fire department right away and canvassed the area. There was no visible fire after Solorio cleared the scene. Once LAFD showed up, they conduct a thorough inspection and alerted Solorio that it was a false alarm. Solorio waited until he was cleared by the fire department to resume his routine night patrol.

**December 6, 2019** - At about 0910 hours, Sergeant Perchlak and Officer Castaneda received a call about an individual blocking a business entrance at 531 South Broadway. Upon arrival, safety ambassadors were able to locate the subject and proceeded forward to make contact. Without provocation, the subject laying down immediately jolted up and threw a punch at Sergeant Perchlak. Officer Castaneda reacted by subduing the subject and placing him in handcuffs. LAFD arrived on scene shortly after and assessed Sergeant Perchlak. LAPD also arrived on scene minutes later and took the suspect in for battery charges. Sergeant Perchlak was also cleared from the scene by paramedics once they determined that the punch resulted in a minor injury.

**December 10, 2019** - At approximately 1800 hours, Sergeant Ramos and Officer Cruz received a service call regarding a shoplifting suspect at the Ross located on the 700th block of Broadway. Upon arrival, safety ambassadors were unable to locate the suspect in question. Safety ambassadors then went around the corner and asked citizens if they saw anyone who matched that description. A concerned citizen then told safety ambassadors that they

saw someone who fit the description enter the Starbucks on 6th and spring. Sergeant Ramos was able to locate the individual but did not engage in contact. Instead, he called LAPD and kept a close visual on the suspect. LAPD arrived shortly after and did a small search on the suspect. The suspect was found with multiple Ross items and booked on shoplifting charges.

**December 17, 2019** - At approximately 0100 hours, Sergeant Ramirez and Officer Sweeney were flagged down by two citizens on the corner of 5th and Broadway. The citizens claimed that they saw a female who was heavily intoxicated in front of mezcalero. Sergeant Ramirez and Officer Sweeney were able to locate the female in question. While attempting to talk to the female subject, safety ambassadors noticed that she was barely able to stand/walk. Officer Sweeney placed a call to LAFD and explained the situation. Within minutes a sobriety unit came out to the scene and assessed the female subject. She was then transported to a sobering center because of her current state.

**December 22, 2019** - While on patrol at approximately 2230 hours, Sergeant Ramirez noticed a couple of citizens crowding the share center at the 400th block of Broadway. Ramirez was then notified by the group of people that the man wearing all black riding a bike down the street assaulted them. Sergeant Ramirez called for backup and intercepted the suspect in question. An LAPD unit that was passing by was also flagged down when safety ambassadors arrived. Once the share workers positively identified the assailant, LAPD took the suspect into custody for assault charges.

#### ACCOMPLISHMENTS

**December 12, 2019** - At approximately 1400 hours, Captain Pacheco and Sergeant Guzman were on their routine patrol when they were flagged down by the security guard at 215 West 5th street. The guard then told safety ambassadors that there was a trespasser inside his building. Captain Pacheco and Sergeant Guzman were able to locate the individual hiding behind a door prop. A short struggled ensued but safety ambassadors were able to control and detain the suspect. When LAPD arrived on scene to transport the individual, the suspect told LAPD officers that he gained entry though the Walgreens on 5th and Broadway. He was then booked on burglary charges for attempting to steal pharmaceuticals.



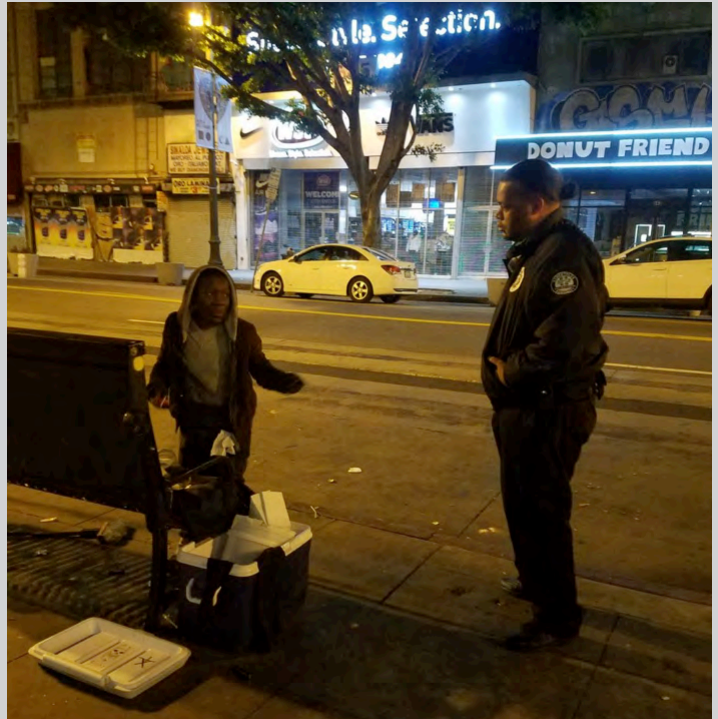

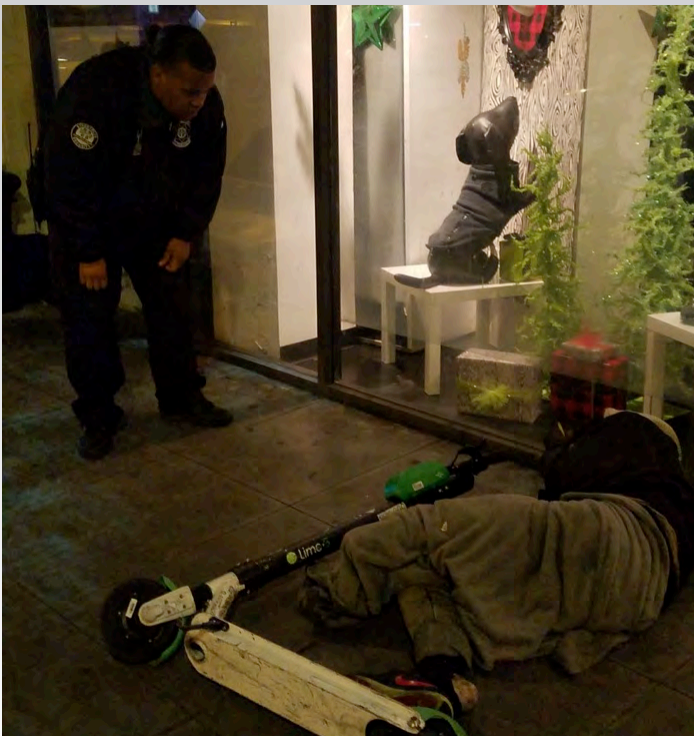

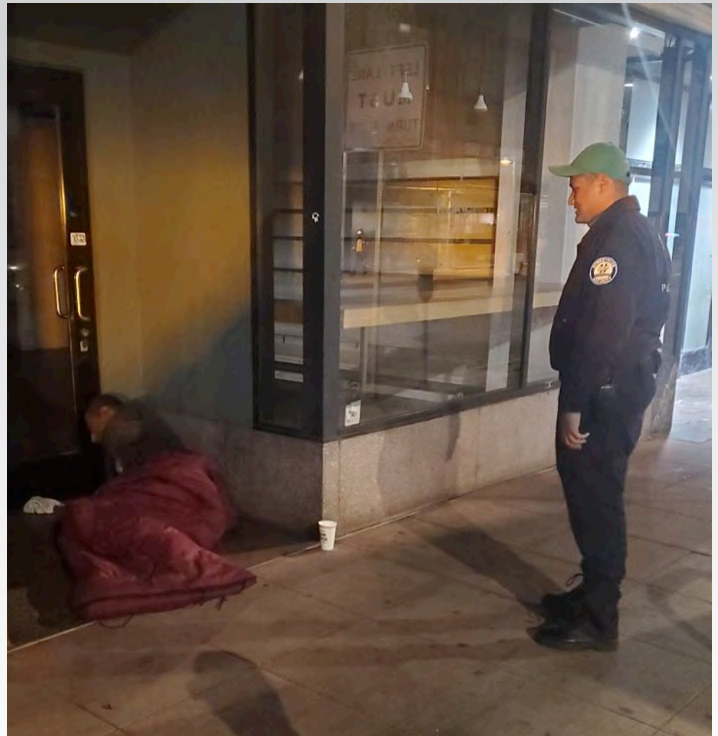

Officer Ajaa likes to keep the community clean by picking up fallen scooters.



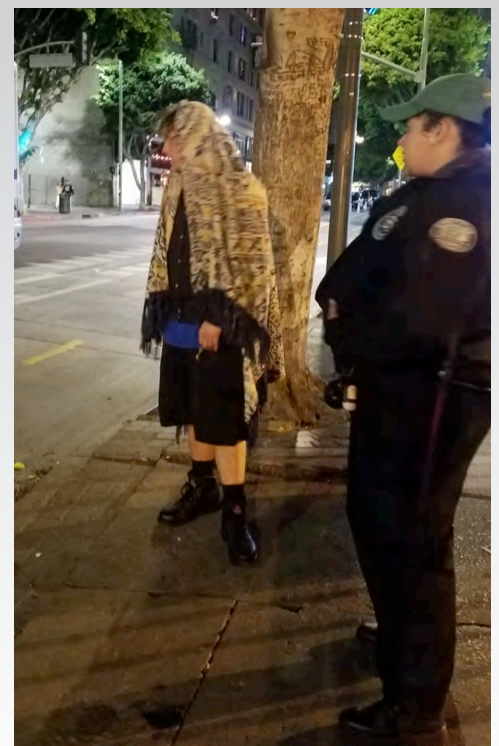
The LA barber college staff thanked the safety ambassadors with a gift basket.
